## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE RADIOS FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS UNDER A STATE TERM SCHEDULE CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the current handheld radios used by the police department are at end of life and will no longer be serviced by manufacturer; and

WHEREAS, Council approved the purchase of new radios as part of the five-year budget (2023-27) to be purchased in 2024 at a budgeted amount of \$270,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the state term pricing will increase in 2024 resulting in a cost within \$10,000 of the budgeted amount; and

WHEREAS, the cost if purchased before November 24, 2023, is \$201,188 resulting in an expenditure of \$62,744 less than the budgeted amount; and

WHEREAS, the purchase will require a supplemental appropriation to make the purchase this year but will eliminate the item from next year's budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 6.04, the City of Hudson may purchase vehicles and equipment through the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") State Purchasing Contract and the Ohio State Term Schedule ("STS") Purchasing Contract and this purchase would be pursuant to Ohio State Term Schedule #573077-0.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of police radios in an amount not to exceed two hundred one thousand one hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$201,188) as detailed in the attached quote under the State Term Schedule Purchasing contract number 573077-0 from Motorola Solutions, Inc.
  - <u>Section 2</u>. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
