A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT (NEORSD) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE NEORSD COMMUNITY COST SHARE PROGRAM FOR DESIGN OF THE RAVENNA STREET STORMWATER MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District's (NEORSD) Community Cost Share Program provides funding to member communities, like the City of Hudson, for community specific stormwater management projects; and

WHEREAS, these funds would be used to reimburse the City for the design, engineering and other approved costs associated with the Ravenna Street Stormwater Management Improvements Project, with construction being anticipated in 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the project will reduce flooding to Ravenna Street residences and, being upstream of the Barlow Community Center Dams, will increase the benefit to the downtown properties; and

WHEREAS, the City's total reimbursement request for design costs to the NEORSD Community Cost Share Program would be \$20,802.90; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Hudson and its residents for the City administration to apply for and accept said funding from NEORSD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter and do all things necessary to administer and accept any award as a party to a Community Cost-Share Agreement by and between NEORSD and the City of Hudson for reimbursement of the cost of the design, engineering and/or construction of the Ravenna Street Stormwater Management Improvements Project, pursuant to the terms and conditions of such agreement(s) as approved by the City Solicitor.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
