

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THAYER POWER & COMMUNICATIONS FOR FIBER OPTIC CABLE INSTALLATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for aerial installation of broadband fiber optic cable on Darrow Road and Hudson Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended that the bid of Thayer Power & Communications be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid and to add to the contract \$60,740 in alternate work for aerial installation of broadband fiber optic cable on Terex Road and West Streetsboro Street; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Thayer Power & Communications as being the lowest and best bid and to approve the amount of the alternate work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of Thayer Power & Communications for the aerial installation of broadband fiber optic cable on Darrow Road, Hudson Drive, Terex Road, and West Streetsboro Street, in the amount of \$62,267, plus \$69,851 for alternate work, which includes a 15% contingency amount, for a total contract amount of \$132,118, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Thayer Power & Communications for said amount.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid services be expedited for the provision of public services; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
