

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF BATH
FOR ROLLOVER 911 SERVICES.

WHEREAS, in order to improve public safety services and protect against situations where 911 callers are not able to get through to a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), both Bath and Hudson have agreed to assist each other's PSAP centers with virtual partnered dispatching services; and

WHEREAS, both Bath and Hudson operate independent PSAPs and will continue to operate their PSAPs independently; and

WHEREAS, both Bath and Hudson PSAPs will accept 911 rollover calls in situations where the initial 911 call cannot be answered by the destination PSAP; and

WHEREAS, if a rollover 911 call is received by either Bath or Hudson, then the receiving dispatcher will attempt to contact safety services for the 911 caller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with The Township of Bath for 911 rollover services attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, on behalf of the City of Hudson.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
