A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH M.A.T. CLEANING SERVICE FOR HOUSEKEEPING/CLEANING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, upon competitive bidding, the City of Hudson has previously entered into two-year contracts for housekeeping and general cleaning services at City-owned buildings and facilities and the current contract for such services which will expire on December 31, 2013 and upon competitive bids being obtained, it is recommended by the Public Works Department to enter into a contract for a two (2)-year period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 with the lowest and best bidder, M.A.T. Cleaning Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a two (2)-year contract with M.A.T. Cleaning Service for a term to begin January 1, 2014 and to run through December 31, 2015, in an amount not to exceed <u>\$92,018.00</u> \$110,411.00 per year with the City's option to renew the contract for an additional two (2) years.

Section 2: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
