LEGISLATION: Hudson Heritage Association Proposal for Historic Signs

I. Executive Summary

Hudson Heritage Association has approached the City with a request to add permanent “National Historic District” signs at the entrances to the Historic District.

II. Legislative History

III. Purpose & Explanation

a. HHA is requesting that signs be installed at the entrances to the Historic District on Rt. 91, Rt. 303, and on the triangle at Hudson-Aurora Road heading west into the downtown. They have suggested HHA would design and pay for these signs and the City would supply the posts and install.

IV. Implementation Schedule

a. Ideally, HHA would like them installed before September 16, when the organization will celebrate the 100th birthday of the Hudson Clock Tower with a celebration on the Clock Tower Green.
