

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF EIGHT USED FIRE DEPARTMENT GARAGE DOOR UNITS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has replaced the eight (8) garage door openers in the apparatus bays and the Fire Chief had determined that the eight (8) used garage door opener units and all associated parts, sensors and remotes should be sold as they are no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Fire Department has researched similar used garage door opener units through various sources and found no similar commercial door openers for sale; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Fire Department has confirmed that no other department within the City wants to use the used garage door opener units; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Fire Department inquired with five area fire departments, none of which wanted to buy the used garage door opener units; and

WHEREAS, Medina Township has asked the Hudson Fire Department if they would sell the eight (8) used garage door opener units and all associated parts, sensors and remotes for \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that the eight (8) used garage door opener units and all associated parts, sensors and remotes be sold to Medina Township for \$500.00 on an “as-is” basis; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule authority as exercised through its Charter, the City of Hudson is selling this personal property which is no longer needed for municipal purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to sell the Fire Department’s eight (8) used garage door opener units and all associated parts, sensors and remotes for the sale amount of \$500.00 on an “as-is”, no express or implied warranty basis to Medina Township, Ohio.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to allow for the sale of unneeded City equipment at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
