

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACCEPTANCE OF A
GRANT FROM THE HUDSON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ON BEHALF
OF HUDSON COMMUNITY TELEVISION.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 17-190 on December 5, 2017, to affirm the City Manager's application to the Hudson Community Foundation for a Youth, Education & Recreation Fund Grant for Hudson Community Television; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Community Foundation awarded and the City Manager accepted grant funding on December 26, 2017, in the amount of \$4,413.57 for the purchase of camera equipment to facilitate the recording and production of additional community programming with no matching of funds being required; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council affirms the City Manager's acceptance of Youth, Education & Recreation Fund Grant funding from the Hudson Community Foundation in the amount of \$4,413.57 for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
