#### Budget Information

- Preparation for Five-year Financial Plan and Budget
  - Clinically, Safety and Training Driven
- Sources of revenue
  - 9% of the additional 1% of Income Tax (64%)
  - Ambulance User Fees (72% of Patients) (35%)
  - Outside Training EMT Class and CPR Training (1%)
- Budget impacts
  - Call volume and types of calls.
  - Patients Insurance
  - Resident Status
  - HRA's / HSA (Health Care Reimbursement Accounts / Health Savings Accounts)
  - Member Availability
- Cost pressures
  - Training
  - Equipment
  - Labor
  - Reimbursement

  - Update Facilities
  - New Equipment
  - Recruitment efforts
  - Professional Development of the Volunteers & Compensated Staff
- What could you do proactively if budget was tightened?
  - Reduce Training
