A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO VEHICLES THROUGH THE COMMUNITY, UNIVERSITY & EDUCATION PURCHASING ASSOCIATION (C.U.E.) PROGRAM FOR THE CITY VEHICLE FLEET; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson, as a member of the C.U.E. purchasing cooperative, is permitted to purchase vehicles through its competitive bidding process and as specified in Resolution No. 13-157 of this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of two vehicles for the City's vehicle fleet.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement, through the C.U.E. purchasing program, with Montrose Auto Group for the purchase of one 2014 Ford Explorer and one 2014 Chevrolet 1500 pick up truck at a total cost not to exceed \$59,838.00, and as said amount has been approved in the 2014 City Budget.

Section 2: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid purchase must be made as soon as possible to secure the specific vehicles for the provision of critical public services; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
