

RESOLUTION NO. 14-93

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR SNOW PLOW BLADE CUTTING EDGES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson needs to purchase snow plow blade cutting edges for its snow removal purposes on public streets for the 2014-15 winter season; and

WHEREAS, the City competitively bid the purchase of said cutting edges and the lowest and best bid is from Valk Manufacturing Company;

WHEREAS, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson an agreement with Valk Manufacturing Company, for the purchase of snow plow blade cutting edges at a total cost not to exceed \$40,043.50.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid cutting edges must be specially manufactured and shipped to the City by the vendor prior to the 2014-15 winter season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
