

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVANCES OF LOCAL TAXES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 321.34, all local authorities entitled to advancement of funds must submit a resolution authorizing advances of local taxes each year; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to request advancement of local taxes from the Summit County Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Summit County Fiscal Officer is requested to issue an order to pay to the Finance Director of the City such funds as may be available for distribution by said Fiscal Officer.

Section 2. The City Manager and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to sign the necessary documents to secure such advances and also the secondary documents to secure the semi-annual settlement with the County Fiscal Officer during the calendar year 2026.

Section 3. The authorization herein conferred shall extend to any advances that may be required for tax year 2025, payable in calendar year 2026.

Section 4. The Clerk is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Summit County Fiscal Officer as may be necessary to make this Resolution effective.

Section 5. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
