A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE REINBERGER FOUNDATION FOR THE RENOVATION OF RESTROOMS AT TOWN HALL; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager's Office has applied for a grant from the Reinberger Foundation for the renovation of the restrooms at Town Hall as part of the remodeling of Town Hall for use by the Hudson Fire Department Association, the Hudson Fire Museum and Historic Education Society, and the Destination Hudson Visitor and Education Center; and

WHEREAS, the Reinberger Foundation has awarded a grant of \$20,000 for the renovation of the restrooms at Town Hall, and this Council desires to accept the grant for the purpose set forth above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to accept a grant from the Reinberger Foundation for the renovation of restrooms at Town Hall in the amount of \$20,000.00.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens and visitors to the City of Hudson and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project at the earliest possible time and, therefore, to accept the grant funding for this project; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
