

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO PURCHASE A THIRD POWERED STAIR CHAIR FROM STRYKER EMERGENCY CARE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson received a grant in the amount of \$25,298.70 from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the purchase of two powered stair chairs and is planning to accept those funds in related legislation Resolution No. 23-87; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson EMS has three front line ambulances and needs a third stair chair to properly outfit all three units with the same equipment; and

WHEREAS, a recent price reduction by Stryker allows the opportunity to purchase a third stair chair thereby equally outfitting all three front line ambulances with the same style of powered stair chair; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the third chair will be approximately \$15,500 with the three-chair discount; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in the Fire/EMS account and will be secured with a Q2 appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2: The EMS Department is hereby authorized to purchase an Xpedition Powered Stair Chair from Stryker Medical of Chicago, Illinois at a cost not to exceed fifteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$15,500).

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
