A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT FEDERAL FUNDS THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL BRIDGE PROGRAM FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE DILLMAN DRIVE BRIDGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has applied for and has been awarded \$529.029.00 in federal funds through the Ohio Department of Transportation's ("ODOT") Municipal Bridge Program for the replacement of the Dillman Drive Bridge; and,

WHEREAS, this grant program is utilizing Toll Revenue Credits to provide 95% of eligible costs; and,

WHEREAS, the project grant is eligible for both design and construction costs; and,

WHEREAS, the full project cost estimate is \$556,873.00, with the City's 5% portion of the project being estimated at \$27,844; and,

WHEREAS, ODOT is requesting written acceptance of the awarded funds by December 16, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: That it is in the best interests of the City of Hudson to accept the federal funds awarded to the City through ODOT's Municipal Bridge Program in the amount of \$529.029.00.

- <u>Section 2</u>: The Mayor is authorized to execute the written acceptance of the awarded funds and any paperwork necessary to effectuate the same.
- Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the timely submission and execution of the required paperwork in order to promote highway safety and/or immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the community, and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
