A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY LAND REUTILIZATION CORPORATION FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT MATCHING GRANT FOR THE REUTILIZATION OF THE SITE OF THE CURRENT HUDSON CITY SCHOOLS BUS GARAGE AND CITY OF HUDSON FACILITIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation's ("Land Bank's") Community Development Matching Grant program offers funding support to local communities for improvements to neighborhood and community quality of life initiatives, including revitalizing neighborhoods and returning properties to productive uses; and

WHEREAS, the City's administration is seeking authorization to Council for submission of a grant application to the Land Bank of up to \$50,000.00, for funds to cover the cost of environmental surveys and assessments and necessary demolition of the Hudson City School and the City's electric power facility and salt dome to reutilize the site as part of Phase II of the Downtown Redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, a resolution of this Council is needed to authorize submission of a grant application for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized and directed to apply for the grant set forth in the recitals to this Resolution for an amount up to \$50,000.00.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the grant application is due to be submitted within thirty (30) days; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
