

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED CONTRACT WITH COGENT COMMUNICATIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF AN INTERNET CIRCUIT FOR THE CITY'S VELOCITY BROADBAND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, City Council previously authorized a contract with Cogent Communications for the provision of an internet circuit; and

WHEREAS, during the final contract approval and timeline review, a need for redundancy services was identified, which has an additional \$50/per month associated fee; and

WHEREAS, the City administration now seeks an amendment to the prior approval and agreement is to adjust the services previously approved, to now include an additional monthly programming fee for redundancy configuration; and

WHEREAS, with the additional fee, the total monthly cost will be \$3,162.56 for 36 months, which is still below state term vendor pricing as listed on Ohio DAS MSA0004-2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an amended 36 month contract with Cogent Communications for an internet circuit, including the needed redundancy.

Section 2. The aforesaid contract is in the City and its residents' best interest.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of life, property, public health, safety, public peace, and the general welfare of the City and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter this agreement in a timely fashion due to market and offer conditions and to ensure work during good weather; wherefore, this legislation shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, provided it receives five (5) affirmative votes of members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes are required if all members are present; otherwise it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
