A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. FOR THE DESIGN OF THE VALLEY VIEW ROAD AND HINES HILL ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (City) requested a formal statement of qualifications and proposals (RFP) from seven (7) ODOT qualified civil engineering consulting firms for the analysis, engineering, and design of the Valley View Road and Hines Hill Road Sidewalk Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends awarding a contract to the AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for professional services for design, engineering and surveying consultants (Consultant) for the analysis, engineering, and design of a 5-ft. pedestrian sidewalk along Hines Hill Road from Valley View Road to Glastonbury Drive and Valley View Road from Hunting Hollow Drive to Hines Hill Road, including all items as described in the formal Request for Proposals, in an amount of \$275,979, which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to award said contract to the AECOM Technical Services, Inc. of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 2: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for professional consulting services for the Project, in an amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$275,979.00).

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
