

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GPD GROUP FOR A POST-CONSTRUCTION STUDY OF RAISED CROSSWALKS AND SUPPLEMENTAL TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES ON VARIOUS PUBLIC STREETS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to authorize a contract for the work necessary to perform a post-construction study of raised crosswalks and supplemental traffic control measures on Hudson Street, College Street and Prospect Street and the proposal for these services of the GPD Group is determined to be best suited to complete the work due to GPD Group’s experience in having performed the pre-construction study for these improvements and its extensive knowledge regarding this area and this matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with GPD Group for the work set forth in the preamble to this Resolution in an amount not to exceed \$35,700.00, which amount includes a five percent (5%) contingency of \$1,700.00.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this study to be completed prior to the onset of incremental weather in the winter of 2013-2014; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
