A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SAFETY CAPITAL PROGRAM FROM THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY TO BENEFIT THE HUDSON POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-41 adopted by this Council on March 15, 2016, authorization was given to the City Manager to submit an application to the Ohio Development Services Agency for a Local Government Safety Capital Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Local Government Safety Capital Program Grant application has been accepted for funding to pay a portion of the cost towards the upgrade of the emergency dispatch system to Next Generation 9-1-1; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Safety Capital Program Grant funding will pay \$34,565.00 towards the upgrade cost, and E911 fees funded by subscribers and accumulated by the City's Police Department, in the amount of \$84,242.20, will be used toward the remaining upgrade cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept funding from the Ohio Development Services Agency for a Local Government Safety Capital Program Grant in the amount of \$34,565.00 for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution and to supplement the grant with \$84,242.20 from the City's police department E911 fees.

<u>Section 2</u>: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
