A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DURA MARK, INC. FOR THE 2014 ROAD LINE STRIPING AND PAINTING PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the City's road line striping and painting program; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and City Engineer have recommended that the bid of Dura Mark, Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Dura Mark, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The bid of Dura Mark, Inc. for the line striping and painting program in the amount of \$129,149.61, which includes a 10% contingency amount, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Dura Mark, Inc. for said amount.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the motoring public during the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
