A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO SUMMIT COUNTY REWORKS FOR A COMMUNITY RECYCLING ASSISTANCE GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is seeking funding from ReWorks through a Community Recycling Assistance Grant to help offset the cost of the City's leaf collection program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is eligible for \$22,133.00 in ReWorks Community Recycling Assistant Grant funding to be used to help defray the City of Hudson's costs of leaf collection services and related costs during the current calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to submit an application to ReWorks for said grant is March 10, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, no matching funds will be required of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council hereby authorizes and affirms the action of the City Manager's designee to apply to ReWorks for a 2023 Grant and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.
 - <u>Section 2.</u> That the above recitals are fully incorporated herein.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of City residents, the timely completion and submission of the ReWorks application to ensure compliance with the Grant, and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
