A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON FOR FIRE HYDRANT INSTALLATION AND ROAD RESURFACING OF PORTIONS OF MIDDLETON AND DARROW ROADS AS PART OF THE AKRON WATER MAIN REHABILITATION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Akron for the installation of five fire hydrants and the cost of milling and resurfacing of Middleton and Darrow Roads as part of the City of Akron's water main rehabilitation project in a total amount not to exceed \$408,664.85.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the agreement authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to commence and complete the within public improvement project at the earliest possible time in this construction season for the safety of the public and properties in the vicinity of the project; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
