

## Peer City Comparison – High Grass Ordinance

City	High Grass text
<b>Twinsburg</b>	of any lot or parcel of land situated within the corporate limits, whether the same be improved or unimproved,
<b>Stow</b>	on any lands located within City of Stow
<b>Kent</b>	(1) Within any public right-of-way; (2) Developed or occupied lots within any duly recorded residential or industrial subdivision.
<b>Cuyahoga Falls</b>	Any grass in excess of eight inches in height;
<b>Dublin</b>	shall permit noxious weeds or grass to grow thereon to a height in excess of six inches
<b>Hudson (current)</b>	any lot or parcel of land situated in a platted and improved subdivision within the City, whether the same be vacant or occupied.
<b>Hudson (Proposed)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. developed or improved parcel</li> <li>b. parcel situated in a platted and improved subdivision</li> <li>c. land within any public right of way or within 20 feet of any public right of way</li> </ul>
