

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH OLD DOMINION BRUSH COMPANY, INC. FOR TWO LEAF VACUUM TRAILERS FOR PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Public Works Department is in need of two (2) replacement leaf vacuum trailers as soon as possible to meet the need for leaf collection services on an ongoing basis and to secure the lowest cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is authorized to purchase vehicles and related equipment through the National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA") which entity employs competitive bidding processes for vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price for two (2) leaf vacuum trailers from Old Dominion Brush Company, Inc. pursuant to the NJPA Contract No. 060612-ODB.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Old Dominion Brush Company, Inc. for the purchase of two (2) leaf vacuum trailers at a total cost not to exceed \$98,645.00.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this purchase to be made to continue ongoing leaf collection services and to do so timely so as to secure the lowest cost; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
