CITY OF HUDSON VARIANCE NOTES FOR MARCH 2012 FINANCIAL REPORT

REVENUE:

2011 Year-To-Date (YTD) vs. 2012 YTD Actual

Real and Personal Property Taxes are \$280,000 lower in 2012 due a larger advance received in 2011. We should receive the first half settlement in April.

Income Tax revenues are \$61,000 lower in 2012 due to decreased withholding and net profit tax payments as compared to 2011. Withholding taxes are down 2.7%, Net Profit taxes are down 29.7% and Individual taxes are up 25.9%. Including Parks, Fire, EMS and Hudson Schools, income taxes are down \$52,000 or 1.3%.

Withholding taxes have improved from last month and the large increase in individual tax revenue has offset most of the overall decrease. As previously noted, it is not known if the decrease in Net Profit taxes will improve as there were some significant payments in 2011 that report \$0 due for 2012.

Local Government Funds are \$35,000 lower in 2012 due to cuts in state funding.

Estate Tax is \$252,000 higher in 2012 due to increased estate tax payments in the 2012 first half settlement. We have exceeded our budget for all of 2012 by \$85,000.

Interest Income is \$82,000 lower in 2012 due to the overall lower interest rates. We expect this downward trend to continue as investments mature and are re-invested at significantly lower rates.

Cable TV is \$83,000 higher in 2012 primarily due to the fund receiving a \$75,000 advance from the General Fund in January 2012.

Fire Department is \$72,000 lower in 2012 due to \$53,000 in Fire Act grant revenue and \$19,000 in proceeds from the sale of vehicles received in 2011.

Water is \$68,000 higher in 2012 due to increased rates and customer sales vs. 2011.

Electric is \$318,000 higher in 2012 primarily due to increased customer sales vs. 2011.

Storm Water is \$74,000 lower in 2012 due to decreased transfer from the General Fund vs. 2011.

EXPENDITURES:

2011 YTD Actual vs. 2012 YTD Actual

General Fund expenditures have increased \$558,000 through March 2012 as compared to March 2011. The largest increases are as follows:

Police increased \$50,000 primarily due to the payment of radio installation and timing of the information services charges. **Street Trees** increased \$50,000 due to increased tree trimming and landscape maintenance; **City Solicitor** increased \$25,000 due to increased legal costs; **Finance** increased \$24,000 due to severance pay in 2012, timing of information services charges and increased postage; and **Public Properties** decreased \$63,000 primarily due to decreased snow and ice removal cost. For the **YDC property**, we've spent \$128,000 on maintenance through March. This includes \$55,000 in natural gas and \$49,000 in water. The high water bill covers all of 2011

and was due to multiple leaks in the line that have since been repaired. Our transfers and advances out increased \$414,000 due to the advance to Cable TV, increased transfers to our Economic Development Fund and Street Construction Fund.

Street Maintenance & Repair expenditures are \$247,000 higher in 2011 due to \$218,000 reduced road salt purchases and reduced contractual snow removal payments and overtime through March 2011 vs. March 2012.

Parks Fund expenditures are \$207,000 higher in 2012 primarily due to payments for the Veteran's Way Park project.

Cable TV Fund expenditures are \$71,000 higher in 2012 due to the purchase of replacement cameras and related equipment.

Wastewater Fund expenditures are \$306,000 higher in 2012 due to \$290,000 increased payments to NEORSD vs. 2011 due to increased rates and wet weather. Note – the payments made in 2012 are for Sept- Dec 2011.

Fleet Fund expenditures are \$146,000 higher in 2012 due to payments for two Service Department trucks and an Electric Department aerial truck in 2012.

2012 YTD Actual vs. 2012 Budget

Revenues are within a reasonable variance range with the exception of water and electric customer sales being higher as discussed above. General Fund Miscellaneous Revenue is \$62,000 higher than projected due to the payment from AT&T for the Hines Hill Rd tower rent. Expenditures are generally favorable or reasonably close to budget with the exception of Public Properties. This is due to larger than budgeted expenses for the YDC property, as discussed above. The golf course expenditure variance will normalize as we move through the golfing season.
