OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RANDSTAD, INC. FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager, along with the Director of Finance, Director of Public Works, City Engineer, and Director of Community Development, have recommended that the City enter into an outside agency temporary staffing agreement with Randstad, Inc. to immediately supplement City staffing as needed for those Departments so as to continue to provide uninterrupted services to the citizens of Hudson: and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to contract with an outside staffing agency for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Sections 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Randstad, Inc. for outside contractual staffing as needed for the City in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for calendar year 2014 and retroactive to January 1, 2014.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue to meet temporary staffing needs of various departments in the City in order to continue vital and uninterrupted City services; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
