A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR A GRANT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO HUDSON COMMUNITY TELEVISION.

WHEREAS, the Hudson Community Foundation provides grant funding to non-profit charitable organizations and government agencies for arts and culture; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Community Television is seeking \$4,413.57, with no matching funds required on the City's part, for the purchase of camera equipment to facilitate the recording and production of additional community programming; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted a grant application by the deadline of December 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council hereby affirms the City Manager's actions to execute and file an application with the Hudson Community Foundation, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
