WHEREAS, Ginny was the school district representative when Hudson Cable Television Advisory Committee was formed in 1996, and was responsible for the school district side of the community partnership and was instrumental in placing HCTV inside Hudson High School; and

WHEREAS, City Council appointed Ginny to the HCTV Committee on July 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Ginny volunteered to run the camera for school board meetings for over 20 years, which was an important aspect of the creation of HCTV; and

WHEREAS, Ginny regularly organized Hudson High School football watch parties in The Bistro at Laurel Lake for Laurel Lake residents; and

WHEREAS, Ginny helped produce many shows, including interviewing an air traffic controller, a resident of Laurel Lake, who was on duty on 9/11 at the Pittsburgh Airport, a show on the comprehensive history of the Hudson Safety Town Program, in addition to other videos about the schools; and

WHEREAS, Ginny was re-appointed to HCTV Committee several times and is also an active member of the Friends of HCTV .
