A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE DISTRICT 8 NATURAL RESOURCES ASSISTANCE COUNCIL FOR CLEAN OHIO CONSERVATION PROGRAM FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council provides Clean Ohio Conservation Funds, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, for projects that protect and enhance streams, rivers and lakes; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund could provide up to 75% of estimated costs for the proposed Brandywine Creek tributary enhancement project between Owen Brown Street and State Route 303.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager is authorized to apply to the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council for a Clean Ohio Conservation Fund Grant for the Brandywine Creek tributary enhancement project for the reason set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the general welfare of the City and its residents for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
