

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER’S DESIGNEE TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO FOUR COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION (NEFCO) FOR A SUMMIT COUNTY BROWNFIELDS PROGRAM GRANT.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides funding for surveys and assessments of potential Brownfields through the Summit County Brownfields Program managed by NEFCO in partnership with the Development Finance Authority of Summit County and the Summit County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, NEFCO could provide assessment services through their contracted environmental consulting firms for the Phase II environmental investigation on the Windstream parcels being purchased by the City that are within the Phase II Downtown Development area; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager’s designee has submitted such a Grant application by the deadline of June 6, 2016, and this Council supports and desires to affirm such submission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby supports and affirms the City Manager’s designee’s action to submit an application to NEFCO, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
