



## **RESOLUTION NO. 16-47**

### **A RESOLUTION HONORING AND THANKING MR. KEITH W. SMITH FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Keith W. Smith was appointed by City Council on October 12, 2010, to serve on the Economic Growth Board and the Golf Advisory Board; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Smith was appointed by City Council on January 8, 2013, to serve as the Ward 4 Council representative; whereupon he resigned from his Board positions; and

**WHEREAS**, in November, 2013, Ward 4 voters elected Mr. Smith to continue serving as their Council representative; and he was re-elected by voters in November, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure on Council, Mr. Smith served as liaison to the Board of Zoning and Building Appeals and Park Board, and as a member of the Golf Advisory Board, Tax Incentive Review Council, and the 2015 Ad Hoc Finance Subcommittee of Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Smith has exemplified the spirit and meaning of true citizen involvement and dedication in his efforts to serve his community and help make Hudson a better place in which to live, work and raise children; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Smith will be moving out of Ward 4 and has therefore submitted notice of his resignation, effective after the Council meeting of April 5, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to publicly thank and honor Mr. Smith for sharing his time, talents and expertise for the good of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the citizens of this community, expresses its thanks and gratitude to Mr. Keith W. Smith for five and one half years of dedicated public service to the community.
