A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT AND BAKER VEHICLE SYSTEMS FOR REPLACEMENT PURCHASES OF GROUNDS MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City needs to replace one (1) turf sprayer machine, three (3) rotary mowers, and two (2) infield rakes in order to meet grounds maintenance requirements for parks, golf course, and cemetery operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase equipment through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, which entity employs competitive bidding processes for such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained price quotes from Century Equipment, Twinsburg, Ohio, and Baker Vehicle Systems, Macedonia, Ohio, both of which are authorized State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program vendors under State Term Contracts #800816-STS515 and #800261 respectively, for the purchase of said equipment for the purpose of replacing equipment at the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of said equipment from Century Equipment in the amount of \$78,412.94 and from Baker Vehicle Systems in the amount of \$34,725.00 to replace equipment in the City's Parks, Cemeteries and Golf Course Divisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into purchase agreements with Century Equipment, Twinsburg, Ohio, and Baker Vehicle Systems, Macedonia, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contracts Nos. 800816-STS515 and 800261 respectively, for the purchase of (1) turf sprayer machine, three (3) rotary mowers and two (2) infield rakes in amounts not to exceed \$78,412.94 with Century Equipment and \$34,725.00 with Baker Vehicle Systems and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall tak	te effect and be in force from and after the earliest
period allowed by law.
