AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 294 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGARDING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, after reviewing the mission of each Board and Commission and the workflows in peer communities, it has been determined that the mission of the Economic Development Incentive Committee ("EDIC") could be carried out by City staff, directly forwarding an incentive application to City Council, and inviting representatives of the Hudson City Schools and/or School Board to the Executive Session when applicable; and

WHEREAS, this change in process would reduce application processing time, scheduling conflicts, and allow for open dialogue between City Council and Hudson Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Chapter 294 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hudson is hereby repealed and rescinded.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
