Replacing T1-11 siding around front door entry with LP Smartside Textured Cedar Shake Siding and replacing aluminum siding (which has been damaged while working on our window addition) on the two exterior walls surrounding window addition on right rear of house with LP Smartside Textured Cedar Shake Siding.

Shake siding was a part of our window addition plans and we love the look of the shake creating focal points as it is aesthetically pleasing. We want to create two main focal points on the house with this alteration, one on the North Side (front door) and one on the South Side (large kitchen windows and house bump out from rear main mass).
