

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PALMER & SON EXCAVATING FOR THE WILLIAMSBURG COLONY STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is planning to remove and replace an existing storm sewer in a City storm sewer easement which has failed and is located behind 5752 Williamsburg Circle; and, pursuant to law, the City requested competitive bids for the construction of the project, whereby three bids were received and Palmer & Son Excavating was the lowest and determined to be the best bid for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Palmer & Son Excavating for the Williamsburg Colony storm sewer improvement project in an amount not to exceed \$26,992.35, which amount includes an additional 10% contingency amount.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this important storm sewer improvement project to be completed at the earliest possible time so as to continue to provide critical storm sewer service to City property owners and residents and to do so within this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
