

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT BUILDING DEMOLITION AND SITE REVITALIZATION PROGRAM THROUGH THE SUMMIT COUNTY LAND BANK.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development's Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program offers grant funding to assist with the demolition of commercial and residential properties and revitalization of those properties; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has applied for said grant assistance with the estimated cost of the demolition, removal and contingency for the house and two outbuildings at 2217 Ravenna Street, which was recently purchased by the City for storm water purposes.

WHEREAS, with the total project cost estimated at approximately \$93,390.00, the City could receive \$84,051.00 (90%) in grant funding and would be required to fund the remaining \$9,339.00 (10%); and

WHEREAS, Staff has submitted a grant application to the Summit County Land Bank, the lead agency for grant funds awarded in Summit Council, by the deadline of December 21, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file an application for grant funding to the Ohio Department of Development Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program through the Summit County Land Bank, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
