

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF A GRANT TO PROVIDE ELECTRONIC TABLETS FOR HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND THE OHIO HIGHWAY PATROL, OHIO TRAFFIC SAFETY OFFICE/TRAFFIC RECORDS COORDINATING COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 18-39 on March 20, 2018, authorizing the City Manager or her designee to submit an application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee to provide up to ten (10) iPads to be used by Hudson Emergency Medical Service for data reporting; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee has awarded Hudson EMS with three (3) iPads, valued at one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to affirm the acceptance of said grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council affirms acceptance by the City Manager's designee of the three (3) iPads to be used by Hudson EMS through the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee valued at one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for the purpose set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
