

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VIZMEG LANDSCAPE, INC. FOR LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE SERVICES ON CITY GREENS AND PUBLIC PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were solicited for landscaping maintenance services on City greens and public properties for a two-year time period from January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2021, with an option for a two-year renewal at the end of the two-year term; and

WHEREAS, Vizmeg Landscape, Inc., Stow, Ohio, was the sole bidder.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a service contract with Vizmeg Landscape, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into a two (2)-year contract with Vizmeg Landscape, Inc., Stow, Ohio, for a term to begin January 1, 2020, and to run through December 31, 2021, in the annual amount not to exceed Forty Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$40,329.30), which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency amount for scope of service changes that may occur, subject to appropriations by Council for each year.

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to exercise an option to renew said contract for up to two (2) additional years dependent upon pricing and quality of service and subject to appropriations by Council.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
