AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE NORTON ROAD/STATE ROUTE 91 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PID # 93452)

WHEREAS, a portion of the Norton Road and State Route 91 intersection is located in the City of Stow and a portion of the Norton Road and State Route 91 intersection is located in the City of Hudson; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer for the City of Stow (hereinafter referred to as "Stow") and the City Engineer for the City of Hudson (hereinafter referred to as "Hudson") have recommended that the engineering plans be prepared for the improvements to the Norton Road/State Route 91 intersection (PID #93452) (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Hudson has enacted Resolution No. 12-136 authorizing its City Manager to enter into agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") necessary for the completion of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, premises, conditions and terms to be kept and performed, it is agreed between the parties as follows:

SECTION 1. CONSENT

Stow hereby gives its consent for Hudson to act as its contractual agent in connection with the Project.

Hudson agrees to act as the contractual agent for Stow in connection with the Project.

Stow hereby approves and ratifies all contracts which Hudson has entered or may enter into on its behalf which pertain to the Project where such written approval has been provided by Stow. Further, Stow releases and holds Hudson harmless from any liability Hudson may incur for any agreement Hudson has entered or may enter into on Stow's behalf pertaining to the Project where such written approval has been provided by Stow.

SECTION 2. COOPERATION

Stow and Hudson each agree to cooperate with respect to the engineering, survey, construction, and payment for the Project.

SECTION 3. PARTICIPATION

A. Hudson agrees to:

1. Enter into such agreements as are necessary to complete the Project.

B. Stow agrees to:

- 1. Provide Hudson with all information necessary for the Project including all available information, reports, plans, utility systems and other data pertinent to the Project.
- 2. Examine all studies, reports, sketches, estimates and other documents presented by Hudson and render, in writing, decisions pertaining thereto within a reasonable time so as not to delay the Project.
- 3. Assign a contact person authorized to act as agent for Stow to review and approve documents, invoices for payment and otherwise represent Stow with regard to all other matters dealing with the Project as it pertains to Stow.
- C. It is agreed and understood between Hudson and Stow that Hudson shall complete the construction plans, advertise for bids, and award a contract for the Project.
- D. It is agreed and understood between Hudson and Stow that Hudson will be the lead agency for the Project.

SECTION 4. FUNDING/PAYMENT

- A. Funding for the Project is with Federal Surface Transportation Program/ODOT funds and with local funds. The local costs will be divided on a 50/50 basis between Hudson and Stow.
- B. Hudson shall receive and process all Project documents and invoices. Upon receipt of an invoice for professional consulting services and construction related to the Project, Hudson and Stow agree to each make payment of 50 percent of the total invoiced amount for the local share of the Project within the time period for payment of invoices set forth in the contracts for the services and materials that are being invoiced.

SECTION 5. EXTENT OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral. This agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by all parties.
