



RESOLUTION NO. 19-57

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND THANKING THOR WASBOTTEN FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Mr. Thor Wasbotten was appointed by City Council on February 3, 2015, to serve a partial term on the Community Television Advisory Committee, and he was re-appointed in 2017 to serve an additional full term; and

WHEREAS, Thor's previous experience in the broadcast field proved invaluable to his role and participation on the Committee, and his experience as a teacher gave him the patience and eloquence to effectively and consistently contribute to the Committee's discussions and actions; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, Thor volunteered his time as a camera operator for many Hudson High School football and basketball games, as well as music concerts; he often staffed the HCTV booths at Taste of Hudson and Hudson Farmers Markets events; he rode in the Hudson Memorial Day Parade on the HCTV truck; and he participated in Friends of Hudson Community Television efforts; and

WHEREAS, Thor diligently served as a valued and contributing Community Television Advisory Committee member; and

WHEREAS, Thor resigned his position on the Community Television Advisory Committee, effective April 15, 2019.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to recognize Thor Wasbotten for his service on the Community Television Advisory Committee and for his willingness to share his time and knowledge for the good of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the citizens of Hudson, expresses its thanks and gratitude to Thor Wasbotten for more than four years of dedicated service on the Community Television Advisory Committee.
