A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A PREFABRICATED PUBLIC RESTROOM STRUCTURE FOR THE BARLOW FARM PARK TENNIS AND PICKLEBALL COURTS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Barlow Farm Park Tennis and Pickleball Courts Improvement Project includes a prefabricated concrete public restroom structure as part of the base construction plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City is able to purchase the precast restroom unit in-house at a lessor cost than the project contractor, with such purchase being made utilizing the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program contract # 081721-CXT.

WHEREAS, the original installation charge of the building will be deducted from the construction contract with Mr. Excavator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter an amendment and execute all documents necessary to purchase one (1) prefabricated concrete bathroom structure utilizing the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program contract # 081721-CXT in the amount of \$9,050.00 so long as said amendment shall be in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter any agreement and execute all documents necessary to cause the original charge to be deducted from the construction contract with Mr. Excavator.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of City residents, to allow for the timely purchase within the applicable guidelines, to take advantage of the summer construction season, and meet previously established deadlines, and to allow for the continued operations of the City Public Works-Public Properties and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
