A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") provides Fire Prevention and Safety Grant funding for fire prevention and safety activities; and

WHEREAS, FEMA could provide approximately \$165,741.13 in grant funding on a 90% (FEMA) / 10% (City) matching basis to assist with funding for P-25 compliant equipment and pagers for the Hudson Fire Department and Hudson Emergency Medical Services migration to 800MHz communications.

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee has submitted an application for said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
