

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING APPLICATION SUBMISSION BY THE CITY  
MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES  
AGENCY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY PROGRAM GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency provides grant funding for Local Government Efficiency programs for consultation and training and known as the LeanOhio initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency could provide a Local Government Efficiency Program Grant (the "Grant") for ninety percent (90%) or \$39,600 funding of the \$44,000 cost for training and consulting by University of Akron's UA Solutions for a project to improve efficiencies for utility billing and the Community Development Department's application process, and the City would be responsible for the remaining ten percent (10%) or \$4,400; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee has submitted such a Grant application by the deadline of May 16, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to submit an application to the Ohio Development Services Agency, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
