Reference: School Crossing Guards

Regarding our school crossing guard program, I have included some basic information that I believe addresses some of the questions that were raised at the 08/15/2023 council meeting.

We have four (4) crossing guard locations with four (4) full time guards, each assigned to one of these locations. We also have a couple people that are designated as substitute crossing guards that will fill in when needed.

The four existing crossing guard locations have been strategically chosen to facilitate safe crossing for our students, and the timing of the crossing guards aligns with the varied start and release times of the schools in our community (elementary and middle school).

This approach acknowledges the varied school schedules, routes of travel, and locations of the schools in order to minimize traffic related risks during these critical times of the day. These established locations provide known designated intersections that can be used for students traveling to and from school during normal school hours.
