A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE 2014 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM; TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THEREFOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the School Travel Plan required by the Safe Routes to School Program has been approved by the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") making the City of Hudson and Hudson School District eligible to apply for both infrastructure projects and non-infrastructure programs listed within the School Travel Plan; and

WHEREAS, the grant submission application process requires resolutions from both Hudson City Council and the Hudson Board of Education and this Council determines that it is a worthwhile program for the City of Hudson to participate in and desires to authorize and direct the City Manager to apply for the grant funds and to enter into any agreements related thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to apply to ODOT for the Safe Routes to School Project/Program Grant and to enter into any agreement for the funds related thereto.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Hudson and the school children of Hudson by reason of the necessity to make the improvements by use of the grant funds and to timely file the application for the funds which is due by March 1, 2014; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
