A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 23-162 TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR THE SNOW AND ICE CONTROL PROGRAM CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 23-162 authorized the advertisement, receipt of bids, and award of contracts for capital items, services, equipment, and materials and supplies for Public Works operations as included in the approved 2024 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, as a part of that budget, the City provided for snow and ice control of public properties; and

WHEREAS, the Snow and Ice Control Program is essential for ensuring the safety and accessibility of public properties during winter conditions; and

WHEREAS, the originally allocated funds for the Snow and Ice Control Program were based on historical expenditures but are now determined to be insufficient due to increased service demands, rising material costs, and unforeseen weather conditions; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 23-162 to increase the funding allocation for the Snow and Ice Control Program to ensure continued and effective service delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The funding allocation for the Snow and Ice Control Program contract for public properties, as authorized under Resolution No. 23-162 and listed in its Exhibit "A," is hereby changed to \$350,000, an increase of \$60,000 which shall be funded from the appropriate budgetary reserves.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager and his designees in the Public Works Department are authorized to do all things necessary in order to proceed with contract modifications or additional procurements, as necessary, to accommodate the increased funding and ensure uninterrupted snow and ice control services.
- <u>Section 3</u>. All other provisions of Resolution No. 23-162 shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this Resolution.
- <u>Section 4</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
