

## **RESOLUTION NO. 13-71**

## A RESOLUTION HONORING AND THANKING MR. WAYNE JOHNSON FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY.

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Wayne Johnson served as Chair of the Fire/EMS Deployment Board from March 31, 2011 through March 31, 2013; and,

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Deployment Board is to monitor the health and delivery of services to the community by the Fire and EMS Departments, to ensure that the established service levels are being met, and to continue to meet the growing needs of the community; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Johnson has extensive safety forces experience, serving as a firefighter and EMT with Northfield Village and Macedonia Fire Departments and currently as an Assistant Chief with Shaker Heights Fire Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to recognize Mr. Johnson for his service as Chair of the Fire/EMS Deployment Board and for his willingness to share his time and knowledge for the good of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the citizens of the City, expresses its thanks and gratitude to Mr. Wayne Johnson for two years of service as Chair of the Fire/EMS Deployment Board.
