

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARDINAL ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR ASPHALT STREET REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to competitive bids therefor, this Council has determined to enter into a contract with Cardinal Asphalt Company, Inc., as the lowest and best bidder, for full depth repairs of various asphalt streets throughout the City with a term from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019, and with an option to renew said contract for an additional two (2)-year period if services are deemed acceptable and pricing remains reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Cardinal Asphalt Company, Inc. for a term to begin January 1, 2018, and run through December 31, 2019, in an amount as may be appropriated by this Council, and with the City’s option to renew the contract for up to two (2) years upon terms acceptable to the City.

Section 2. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of Council leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by R.C. 121.22.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
