OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH IVIDEO TECHNOLOGIES FOR A VIDEO PRODUCTION SWITCHER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is authorized to purchase materials and equipment through the State of Ohio Procurement State Term contracts and the State's Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, due to equipment failure, the City's public, education and government ("PEG") access cable television studio (HCTV) is in need of a new video production switcher and components at the earliest possible time to continue to provide cable services; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the equipment can be made from iVideo Technologies of Cleveland, Ohio through the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. STS7758100308-2, in the amount of \$42,022.94.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City with iVideo Technologies of Cleveland, Ohio for the purchase of a video production switcher and components in an amount not to exceed \$42,022.94.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the purchase of the video equipment to continue to provide PEG access services due to the failure of the current equipment; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
